- Registered with the Australian Charities and Not-For-Profit Commission

A not-for-profit organisation which is charitable at law
A legal entity such as an incorporated association or corporation.

The total pool of funding is \$730,000 for the Foundation's activities in 2025. They generally provide grants ranging from \$1,000 up to \$30,000. Larger grants may be made where the proposed project has outstanding merit, sustainability and impact, and clearly meets all ICF criteria. In addition, preference will be given to projects that demonstrate a high degree of self-help, either in the form of the applicant's own efforts and work already undertaken, or in the form of actual physical or financial resources already committed to the project.
