Since starting in 1994, Ansvr's Community Education Program (CEP) has provided a range of grants contributing over \$15 million to help fund over 300+ different charities and not for profit organisations with a focus on supporting the education and life skill development needs of disadvantaged young Australians.

Ansvr's Community Education Program provides a range of grants to organisations supporting Australian youth through programs that fall under two categories – Empowerment and Education, and Outreach and Support.

Empowerment and Education:

- Programs within this category must provide opportunities to develop positive values that lead to healthy lifestyle choices and a positive contribution to our community.

Outreach Programs:

- Programs within this category must support youths who are at risk or are already experiencing difficulties (such as drug and/or alcohol abuse) through rehabilitation and/or skills training.
