

Transurban Community Grants

Funds projects that bring social, road safety and environmental benefits to communities in Melbourne, Sydney and Brisbane near Transurban's roads.

Grants are open to a wide range of organisations and initiatives and Transurban encourages inclusion, diversity of thought and innovation.

Grants of up to \$10,000 per organisation are available for initiatives which enhance:

- Road safety
- Local environment & biodiversity
- Financial and social inclusion.

New grant recipients

- First Nations: As part of our commitment to reconciliation (and our RAP), at least one grant in each eligible state will be awarded to a First Nations organisation or initiative
- People's choice: All of our community also has the chance to vote for grant recipients, with a People's Choice grant awarded to one organisation or initiative in each eligible state.

To be eligible for a Transurban grant your organisation must have Deductible Gift Recipient (DGR) status. DGRs must be listed with the Australian Tax Office (ATO) as per the guidelines in the Income Tax Assessment Act 1936 (Item 1 of the table in Section 30-15).

Your initiative needs to be happening in a local council area with a Transurban road. A list of eligible councils is provided on the Transurban website.
