

# Feed Melbourne Grants

Funds community-based charitable organisations within Greater Melbourne who provide food services or support to their community.

Each year Leader Community News and FareShare, supported by Newman's Own Foundation provide Feed Melbourne Appeal grants of up to \$15,000 to charities within Greater Melbourne. These grants aim to give local charities increased capacity to provide food to people in their communities who are going through tough times. We also distribute a handful of grants to Victorian rural and regional charities each year.

This year, in addition to providing grants for funding for essential equipment, charities can apply for a grant to purchase food. Grants for food are capped at a total of \$10,000.

## Equipment:

Funding is available for equipment such as: Kitchen and storage equipment (e.g. shelving, cupboards and storage containers, refrigerators, freezers, cool rooms, food processors etc., Transportation of food (e.g. refrigerated vehicles or trailers).

## Food:

In response to the growing demand for staple food, food relief charities can now apply for a grant which will provide them with credit to purchase food through PFD Foods or Foodbank Victoria.

To be eligible to apply for a Feed Melbourne Grant, an organisation must be endorsed as a Deductible Gift Recipient (DGR) as covered by Item 1 of the table in section 30-15 of the Income Tax Assessment Act 1997, and as a Tax Concession Charity (TCC).
