Telstra Kids Fund

Enables Telstra employees to nominate a local community organisation and propose an idea to help kids thrive in a connected world.

Due to the ongoing impacts of COVID-19 across communities, Telstra's employee-led change-making program will be back next year.

Telstra Kids applications are a two-part process. When the round opens, all eligible Telstra employees will be able to register their interest online for a \$1,200 Telstra Kids grant on behalf of a local school, kinder, library, or youth-focused community group. Then, through a 'lottery-style' allocation process, a random selection of employees that lodged their application by the deadline will be invited to complete the process with the help of the local community group they nominated.

For part one of the application process, you will need to describe the project i.e. how the funding will be used and how this will benefit kids in your local community to play and learn. You will also need to provide some details of the local community group you're applying on behalf of - so have things like their ABN and their contact details handy.

Only permanent Australian-based Telstra employees who have not received a Telstra Kids grant in the last 3 years can Who Can Apply apply.

Example funding ideas:

- Digital projects including digital making and digital skills programs (coding, robotics, 3D printing and cyber-safety projects)
- Arts and culture projects including musical instruments, art supplies and rock eisteddfods
- Education projects including language programs, playground upgrades and toys
- Nature based and environmental projects including plants for playgrounds, veggie patches and frog bogs
- Health and wellbeing projects including physical therapy programs, nutrition programs, health education and shade sails
- Sports and recreation projects including sports equipment, camping gear, sports uniforms and activity days.
