Ballarat Heritage Restoration Fund

Offers grants to restore eligible heritage places and objects in the Ballarat area.

To be eligible for funding assistance from the Ballarat Heritage Restoration Fund, proposed restoration works must apply to a place of identified historical significance as protected under a heritage overlay in the City of Ballarat, and must:

- Conserve the overall significance of the place
- Involve works that are visible from a public place, focus should be given to the external envelope
- Provide evidence that the work is of a reconstructive or restorative nature (this can be established through building plans, photographs and drawings or through evidence on the place)
- Be put forward by the property owner or a lessee who has the written consent from the owner and who's term of lease is longer than any completion deadline or loan repayment period.

Applications will be accepted at any time, however there are two funding rounds each year with specific cut off dates. Please refer to the funding provider's website for the closing dates for each round.
