

# Reece Grant

Supports locally led initiatives that help communities in Australia and overseas with access to clean water, sanitation or food security through irrigation.

The Reece Foundation support WASH projects that connect skilled volunteer tradespeople to communities in need of access to water and sanitation and/or irrigation and water solutions to food insecurity, both in Australia and overseas.

The Reece Foundation accepts Grant applications that meet the following guidelines:

- The application is submitted by a registered charity or not-for-profit organisation
- Identifies a need for access to clean water, sanitation, or water for agricultural & food security purposes
- Clearly articulates the potential impact on the community
- Outlines how the organisation has consulted with and involved the community in the proposed project development
- Includes the trade-skills required for the project in addressing the need identified by the community
- The funding request is between \$5,000 and \$30,000.

Applicants must be a not-for-profit organisation, community group, or individual or group of individuals sponsored by a not-for-profit entity.

Applications are reviewed on a rolling basis and you will be notified if you have been shortlisted.
