Equity Innovation Grants

Funds initiatives that focus on undergraduate low-SES students, either encouraging their entry to University or supporting their retention, success and completion.

Priority will be given to:

- initiatives that can specifically demonstrate positive influence upon the aspiration, engagement and attainment patterns of low SES prospective students who may not otherwise consider university as a viable choice;
- initiatives to enhance the embedding of support for low SES students within University of Melbourne Undergraduate Degrees, particularly where evidence of opportunities for improvement exists;

- initiatives to enhance success rate of priority low SES cohorts particularly where outcomes will be quantitatively evaluated.

Applications are required to demonstrate faculty financial contributions (which may include in-kind salary costs) and long-term sustainability beyond the duration of the possible EIG funding. Initiatives that involve collaboration between Faculties or Divisions are strongly encouraged.

Please note that the Equity Innovation Grant Scheme should be viewed as providing seed funding for new initiatives for one year only.
