

# The Local Drug Action Team (LDAT) Program

Supports communities to work together to prevent and reduce the harmful effects of alcohol and other drugs (AOD).

The LDAT Program is open to all communities in Australia wanting to prevent and minimise alcohol and other drug issues. The Alcohol and Drug Foundation accepts applications from a range of organisations. These include local councils, health centres, youth services, employment agencies, sports teams, schools, businesses, police among many others.

At a minimum, applicants must:

- Be a legal entity in Australia
- Be willing to partner with at least two other organisations to form a Local Drug Action Team
- Have the capability to auspice the Local Drug Action Team themselves, or a partner that can.

Organisations from across different sectors are encouraged to apply. The Alcohol and Drug Foundation can support organisations that don't have expertise or experience working in the alcohol and other drug field.

Funding of an initial \$10,000 is available for teams to develop a community action plan, with \$30,000 additional funding available to start implementing activities.
