

Wildlife and Habitat Bushfire Recovery Program Grant

Supports the immediate survival and long-term recovery and resilience for fire-affected Australian animals, plants, ecological communities and other natural assets and their cultural values for Indigenous Australians.

The Wildlife and Habitat Bushfire Recovery Program will provide funding to support the immediate survival and long-term recovery and resilience for fire-affected Australian animals, plants, ecological communities and other natural assets and their cultural values for Indigenous Australians.

There is up to \$12 million available for grants under the Program, with grants of between \$100,000 and \$1 million being offered.

It is anticipated that the Program will be delivered over two or more tranches.

Eligibility:

To be eligible for funding you must be an Australian legal entity with an Australian bank account.

Grant Activity Timeframe:

It is anticipated that contracting and initial payments for grants approved through Tranche 1 will be completed by 30 June 2020.

Grant activities must be completed by 30 June 2021.
