Transurban Community Grants

Funds projects that bring road safety, financial inclusion, the environment or STEM benefits to the communities in Greater Melbourne, Sydney or Brisbane near Transurban's roads.

New grant recipients

The organisation with the most votes will receive an additional \$10,000 in funding, while the runner-up will be awarded an extra \$5,000.
