Strata Resilience Program

Helps eligible bodies corporate in coastal Central and North Queensland improve the strength of strata properties against cyclones.

The Strata Resilience Program helps eligible bodies corporate located in a cyclone risk area – in the area from 100 kilometres of the coastline from Rockhampton, north to the Torres Strait and west to the Queensland/Northern Territory border – to improve the resilience of their strata properties against cyclones.

To be eligible to apply, the body corporate must:

- Have participated in the Strata Title Inspection Program and have a copy of the report provided by James Cook University – Cyclone Testing Station
- Have a nominated person to act on behalf of the body corporate as a single point of contact for the program
- Be located in a cyclone risk area (in the area from 100 kilometres of the coastline from Rockhampton, north to the Torres Strait and west to the Queensland/Northern Territory border)

confirm that they have adequate funds to meet cocontribution requirements.

These properties may be eligible to apply for a grant for up to 75% of the cost of eligible improvements identified through the inspection program to \$15,000 (including GST) per residential tenancy to a maximum grant of \$150,000 (including GST) per body corporate.

Funding for the program is limited, and grants will be awarded until the funding capacity is met.
