Construction Visa Subsidy Program

Provides funding to WA construction businesses to support a skilled migration visa pathway.

Funding is available to support WA construction businesses to fill the demand for a skilled workforce.

Applicants may use the subsidy to offset the costs incurred in the migration process, including:

- Recruitment costs
- Fees paid to a registered migration agent
- Visa application fees
- Relocation costs.

To be eligible, employers must sponsor skilled migrants in at least one of the following visa subclasses:

- 482 Temporary Skill Shortage (TSS) Visa medium term (up to 4 years) or short term (up to 2 years)
- 494 Skilled Employer Sponsored Regional (Provisional) Visa – up to 5 years
- 186 Employer Nominated Scheme (ENS) permanent.

Additionally, applicants must:

- Be headquartered and undertaking commercial and/or residential building and construction work in Western Australia, in an eligible occupation
- Have a valid Australian business number (ABN).
