

Rural Support Grants

Provides financial assistance to eligible SA primary producers and rural small business owners experiencing significant financial hardship.

The grant is delivered via the Rural Business Support (RBS) Relief Fund, the charity arm of RBS, and is designed to help families who are working with the Rural Financial Counselling Service, which helps to meet people where they are, providing practical relief so they can focus on finding a way forward.

The \$1,500 grants will assist to help cover essential costs such as:

- Council rates
- Utility bills
- Medical appointments and prescriptions
- Vehicle repairs
- School costs and household needs.

Priority is given to those impacted by drought, market disruptions (such as in the wine grape industry), biosecurity incursions, and family-run rural small businesses concerned about their financial future.

Payments are made directly to suppliers upon invoice, with one grant available per family enterprise.
