Cooperative Research Centre Projects (CRC-P) Grants

Provides industry-led collaborations with short term (up to three years) matched funding to develop important new technologies, products and services.

Projects must:

- Develop a product, service or process that will solve problems for industry and deliver real outcomes
- Benefit small to medium enterprises (SMEs)
- Include education and training activities.

You can use the funding to cover costs directly related to your project including:

- New research
- Proof of concept activities
- Pre-commercialisation of research outcomes
- Industry-focused education and training activities
- Conferences, workshops, symposia related to the joint research
- Information sharing and communications related to the research.

This is not a complete list and other costs may also be eligible.

To be eligible as a lead applicant you must:

- Have an Australian business number (ABN)
- Be incorporated in Australia and a trading corporation.
- Your trading activities must be either: enough to be called a trading corporation or a major, not minor, part of your overall activity
- Project partners must include: 2 Australian industry organisations, including at least 1 SME and 1 Australian research organisation.

The Round is open to all industry sectors however will have a focus on supporting projects that align with the National Manufacturing Priorities.
