

Home and Business Battery Scheme

Supports the Northern Territory Government's plan for 50% renewable energy by 2030, while maintaining secure, reliable and affordable power for Territorian homes and businesses.

As part of this plan, the Territory is introducing the Scheme which will provide home and business owners with a grant to install a solar PV system including a battery, or add a battery to their existing solar PV system.

You can only submit one application per property and per homeowner.

You can apply if you're:

- A registered owner of a residential property in the NT
- A registered NT business
- A not-for-profit or community organisation operating in the NT in either owned or leased premises.

The property can be owner-occupied or used as an investment, but there can only be one application per property and per homeowner.

If you're a homeowner and also own a business, you can apply for one grant for your home and one for your business.

You can use the funding to buy and install:

- A solar photovoltaic (PV) with an eligible battery and inverter
- An eligible battery and inverter only, if you already have solar PV installed.
