SafeWork Small Business Rebate

Helps NSW small business owners, charities and not-forprofits purchase safety items that improve work health and safety.

Small business owners and sole traders who have an ABN and less than 50 full time employees. Charities and not for profits can also apply.

The application must be in the name of the registered business owner.

Charities and not-for-profit organisations that employs between 1-50 full-time workers are eligible.

The most popular safety items are ones that: - Prevent slips, trips and falls, or being hit by moving objects

- Make it safer to lift or move heavy items, including very large items
- Prevent injuries caused by doing the same task often
- Prevent harm from noise
- Make handling and storing chemicals safer
- Help you manage COVID-19.

You may include more than one item with your claim, for example two ladders and one trolley.

Applicants must attend a SafeWork NSW education activity before claiming the rebate and no more than 12 months prior to the date the application is submitted.
